SenSen Receives First International Order for new Al Filtering Solution Clarification

On 15 October 2019, Sensen Networks Limited (ASX: SNS, "SenSen" or "the Company") announced that it had received its first international commercial order to supply its AI-FARM – Artificial Intelligence-based False Alarm Reduction and Management – software solution to a global technology, defence and engineering group based in Singapore ("the Announcement").

SenSen confirms that it does not consider that the Announcement contains information that a reasonable person would expect to have a material effect on the price or value of SenSen's securities, and the Announcement was not made in order to comply with its continuous disclosure obligations under ASX Listing Rule 3.1.

SenSen released the Announcement in order to inform investors of the first international order received for its new AI-FARM solution following its domestic engagement with the Brisbane City Council.

SenSen acknowledges the requirements of announcements under ASX Listing Rule 3.1 and section 4.15 of Guidance Note 8, and confirms as follows:

The term of the Agreement	SenSen and the Singapore-based technology, defence and engineering group (Counterparty) entered into an unconditional agreement for the supply by SenSen of its AI-FARM software solution (Agreement). The Agreement is for a period of four years, commencing in January 2020, and ending on 31 December 2023. The Counterparty may terminate the Agreement earlier for any reason.
The nature of the products to be supplied to the Counterparty:	The SenSen AI-FARM software solution
The significance of the contract to the entity:	The contract is significant to SenSen as it represents an additional product line into Singapore and the first international order for its AI-FARM software solution following its domestic engagement with the Brisbane City Council.
